TODAY IS THE DAY



Prayer

Have you had your first conversation with God? That first conversation must begin with an open heart as to who He is. It must begin with an understanding that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. It must come from a desiring heart and from words of trust.

Like all relationships, there must be an introduction. God knows who you are. He sent His Son to show you how much He knows you and loves you. The question is, do you believe?

Ponder

Ask

What does my relationship with Jesus look like today?

Can you describe your relationship with positive indications? Refrain from using words such as, "I should do more," or "I need to be better..."

Be proud of your relationship! Consider this truth, You {today - as you are/where you are} have a relationship with the God of the Universe. That is huge. That is powerful. That is your truth!

Kingdom of God. I will simply use it today.

Ask

when/with/where _____.

Prayer

In the light of Psalm 126, how do I set my gaze on
the Glorious Day as I sow in tears and
as I reap in joy?
What does that look like and to whom?

Ask

How can I show mercy to the one around me who is
trapped in the evil of this world?
To whom can I speak softly?
To whom can I declare eternal damnation?
May I always remember that my heart is for their soul
to gain eternal joy before the King of kings, not
that I prove myself to be right.

Prayer

There is a grave difference between being in my head

Ask

What am I buying to attain the Kingdom of God?
Furthermore, what am I spending?
Whose resources am I using, mine or my God's?

Prayer

AM I WORTHY?



Prayer

Allow your conversation with God today to include these two aspects

(without time limits, rules, or expectations):

1. Verbally declare the goodness of God. Cast your words of praise at His feet -proclaim who He is.
2. Verbally declare who you are in Him through the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Let your ears hear what your heart needs to remember.

Ponder

We often feel unworthy. Why?

What is it in me that deems myself unworthy?

And, furthermore, what am I unworthy of?

Do I worry that pride will root in me if I declare that I am worthy to be called the daughter of God? If so, how is that pride? Is that not confidence and respect toward the death and resurrection of Jesus?

Ask

What do I want to be worthy of?

In whose eyes do I want to be seen as worthy?

How can I change my perception of God's opinion of me, His daughter?

Prayer

kingdom and your kingdom work today!

Ponder

The disciples stood there gazing into heaven as they

and then they waited.
From the beginning of Acts to the final word written
in Revelation, we see what their waiting looked like
as they were, where they were.
As I read Scripture this week, may I feel what their
waiting and their anticipation felt like.

Ask

How can I follow the disciples example of clinging to
that eternal joy - no matter what?
Life is hard but Jesus!
The disciples understood the power of eternal joy and
taught the first century believers how to live it.
Do I understand? Who can I teach?

Prayer

Ask

Jesus Christ's glorious appearing is coming!
Today, we wait.
How can I be careful to devote myself to good works as I eagerly wait?
May I not be idle in word or deed, but that my work be the very heartbeat of His glorious appearing!
